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# Champagne


Champagne is possibly the world's most famous wine, and one inextricably associated with celebration. This is the most northerly wine region in France. Champagne is usually made from a blend of grapes sourced from different vineyards across this large region, and the varieties used are predominantly Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier.

In Champagne there are around 15,000 growers and 290 champagne houses. Traditionally, growers have sold their grapes to the champagne houses which account for 70% of production and 90% of exports. Recently, increasing numbers of growers are making "grower champagnes" themselves.

# Australia

The Australian wine industry is the world's fourth largest exporter of wine with approximately 750 million litres a year to the international export market with only about 40% of production consumed domestically. Wine is produced in every state, with more than 60 designated wine regions totalling approximately 160,000 hectares; however Australia's wine regions are mainly in the southern, cooler parts of the country, with vineyards located in South Australia, New South Wales, Victoria, Western Australia, Tasmania and Queensland. The wine regions in each of these states produce different wine varieties and styles that take advantage of the particular Terroir such as: climatic differences, topography and soil types. With the major varieties being predominantly Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Merlot, Semillon, Pinot Noir, Riesling, and Sauvignon Blanc. Wines are often labelled with the name of their grape variety, which must constitute at least 85 percent of the wine.

## South Africa

South African wine has a history dating back to 1659 with Constantia, a vineyard near Cape Town, being considered one of the greatest wineries in the world. Access to international markets has unleashed a burst of new energy and new investment. Production is concentrated around Cape Town, with major vineyard and production centres at Paarl, Stellenbosch and Worcester. There are about 60 appellations within the Wine of Origin (WO) system, which was implemented in 1973 with a hierarchy of designated production regions, districts and wards. WO wines must be made 100% from grapes from the designated area. "Single vineyard" wines must come from a defined area of less than 5 hectares. An "Estate Wine" can come from adjacent farms, as long as they are farmed together and wine is produced on site. A ward is an area with a distinctive soil type or climate, and is roughly equivalent to a European appellation.

## Spain

Spanish wines : vinos españoles. Located on the Iberian Peninsula, Spain has over 2.9 million acres planted, making it the most widely planted wine producing nation but it is the third largest producer of wine in the world. This is due, in part, to the very low yields and wide spacing of the old vines planted on the dry, infertile soil found in many Spanish wine regions. Spain has an abundance of native grape varieties, with over 400 varieties planted throughout Spain though 80 percent of the country's wine production is from only 20 grapes, including the reds Tempranillo, Garnacha, and Monastrell. The whites Albariño from Galicia, Palomino, Airen, and Macabeo, along with the three cava grapes Parellada, Xarel·lo, and Macabeo.

## France

The history of French wine, spans a period dating to the founding of Massalia in the 6th century BC by Phocaeans with the possibility that viticulture existed much earlier. The Romans did much to spread viticulture across the land they knew as Gaul, encouraging the planting of vines in areas that would become the well known wine regions of Bordeaux, Burgundy, Alsace, Champagne, Languedoc, Loire Valley and the Rhone.

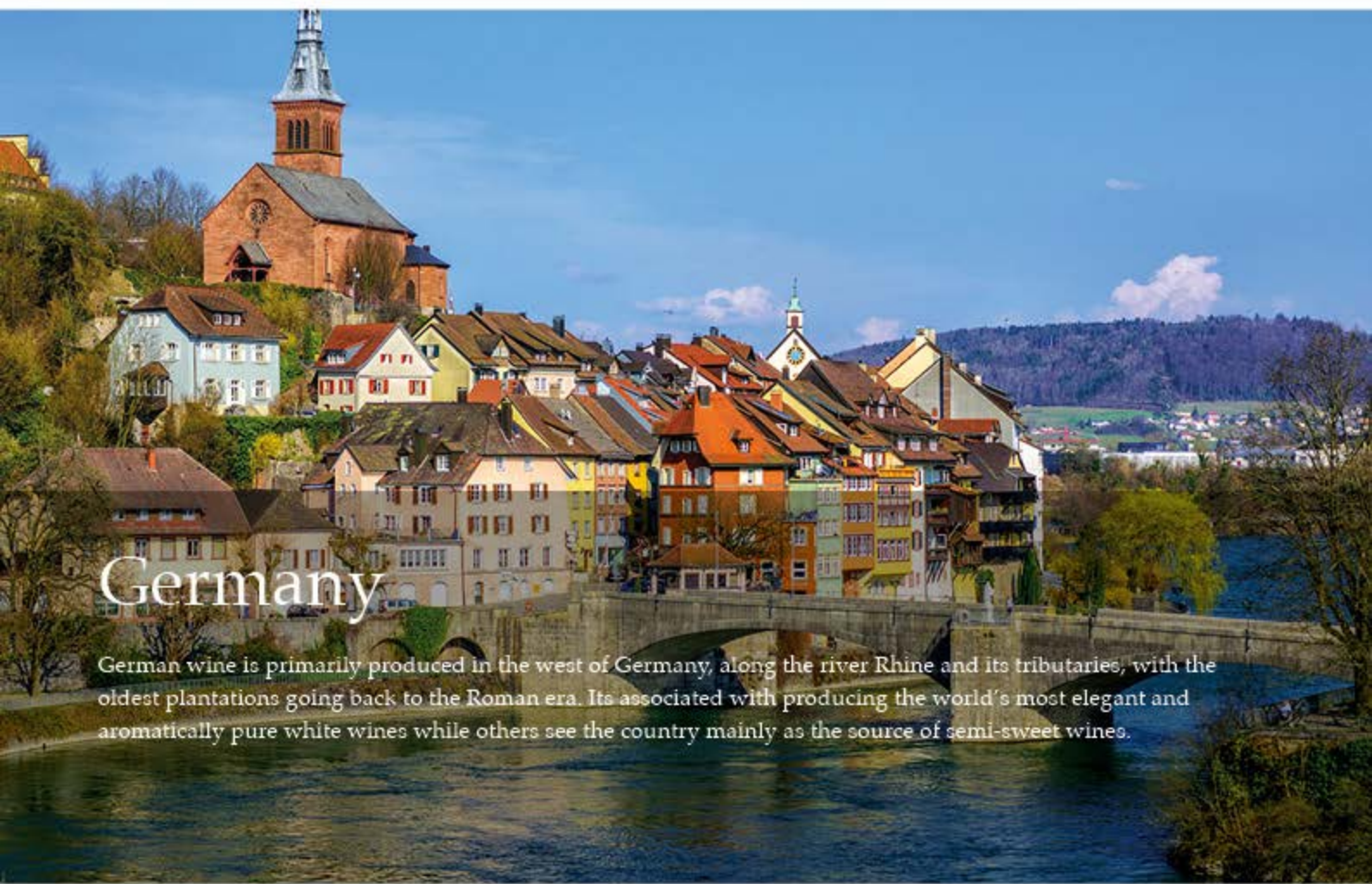

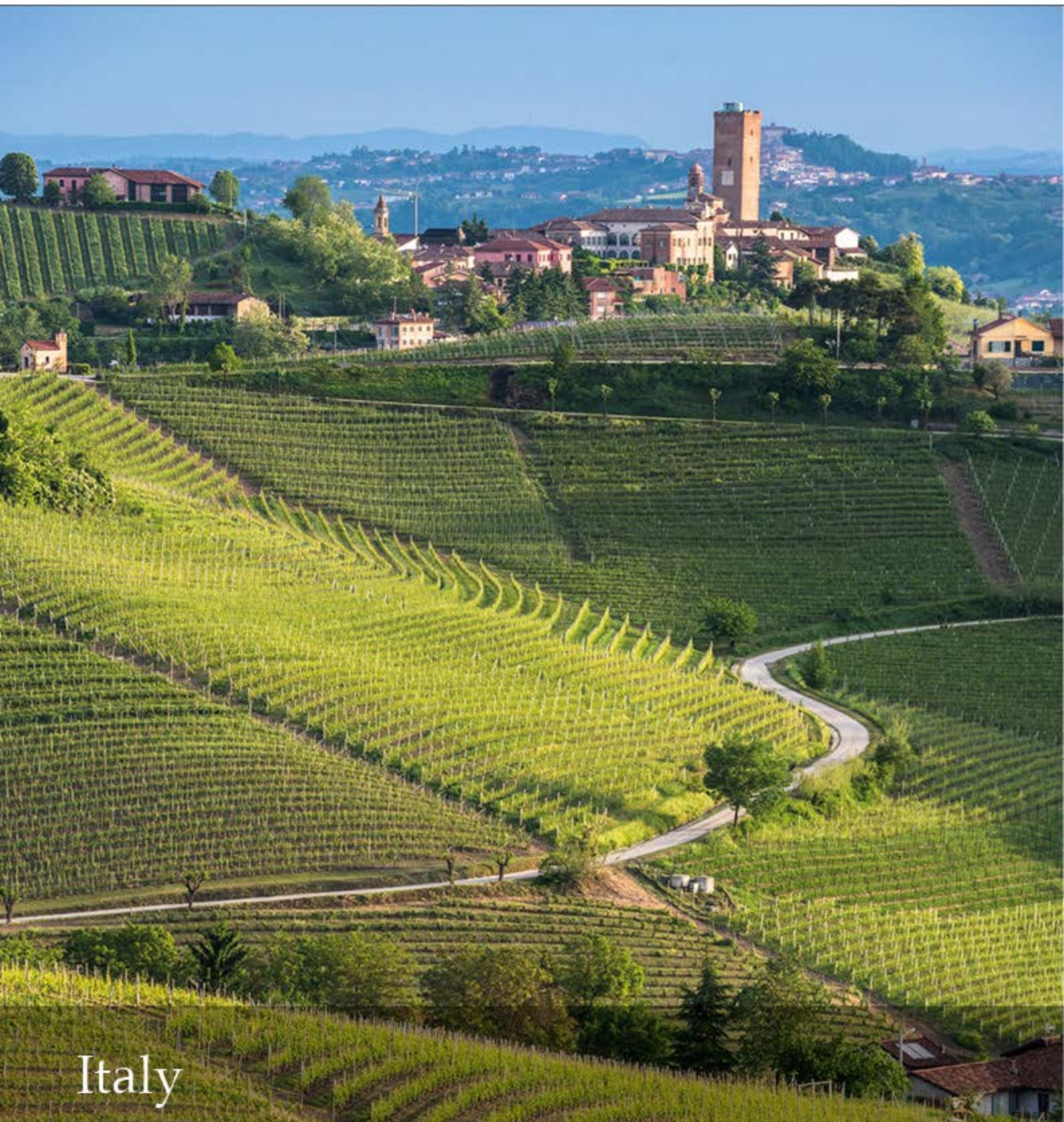




# Germany

## Italy

# Romania

Bats Blood is grown, produced and bottled in Banat which is part of the historic region of Transylvania. It is bottled on the same estate where it is grown and picked. The winery enjoys a Mediterranean climate, cooler than the rest of Romania, and dryer with a longer harvest season, allowing many varieties to ripen easily. Legend has it that the Banat region of Romania was where Bacchus, the God of wine, spent his childhood. Certainly the first records of viticulture date back to the Roman Empire when it invaded and annexed the central part of Dacia in 106 AD.

When planning your wine list you need to work out your pricing model, so to give you a hand we have included a Gross Profit % and Cash Margin guide.

## How do I work out Gross Profit % Pricing and Cash Margin ?

For example if you are looking to make 65% Gross Profit, and your being charged £5.25 per bottle.

Take the cost price £5.25 multiply by 100 divide by 35 (which is 100-65). This gives you £15 to which we add VAT at 20% which comes to £18 as your selling price.

Or the other option is if you want a cash margin of £7, just add £5.25 to £7 and add V.A.T giving a selling price of £14.70
