ARGENTINA

In the centre west of the territory, at the foot of the Andes mountain range, Mendoza holds 75% of the total vineyards in Argentina and the largest number of wineries in the country. This makes it the most important wine province and one of the main producing centres in the world. The highest peaks of the Andes are found in Mendoza: with 22.832 ft, Aconcagua is the highest peak in America.

The presence of the Andes, which act as a barrier to the humid winds of the Pacific, added to the distance to the Atlantic Ocean, shape the climate generating ideal conditions for the cultivation of vines. The altitude, continental climate, heterogeneity of soils and the snow melt are key factors for the production of excellent wines, which add to a significant wine-making tradition.

GOYENECHEA

Their history in wine dates back to 1868 when the first generation of the Goyenechea family arrived as immigrants in Argentina and settled in Villa Atuel, San Rafael, Mendoza.

Today, the winery continues in the family and is run by the fourth and fifth generation family members who keep on working with the same energy and enthusiasm as the founders in achieving the highest standards of excellence in their wines, making Goyenechea one of the oldest established, independent, and family-owned wineries in Argentina.

The grapes come from the vines of their "La Vasconia" Estate of Villa Atuel. The oldest vines date back to 1908. The vineyard surface of the Estate exceeds 140 hectares providing quality grapes from Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Malbec, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc vines amongst others.

The century old winery building has a wine making capacity of over 14 million litres in stainless steel tanks, epoxy lined concrete vats and 225 litre French oak barriques.

Goyenechea wines began to be distributed outside of Argentina over 40 years ago and today enjoy a loyal following of fans around the world.

WOODSTOCK

The original Woodstock property was named by English settlers, after their hometown of Woodstock, near Blenheim Palace in Oxfordshire, England. The Townsend Family, headed by William Louis Townsend, received a Crown Lease for the property in 1905, built a home with a brick well and established the estate as a vineyard and orchard. It has been known as Woodstock ever since.

In the centre of the town of Woodstock in England stands a set of medieval wooden leg stocks, which were historically used for the public punishment of townsfolk who had over-imbibed. A replica of these stocks welcomes visitors at the entrance of Woodstock Estate in McLaren Vale. Incidentally, their much-revered single vineyard Woodstock 'The Stocks' Shiraz, sourced exclusively from 31 rows of old Shiraz vines (planted circa 1900), has been cheekily named after this set of stocks!

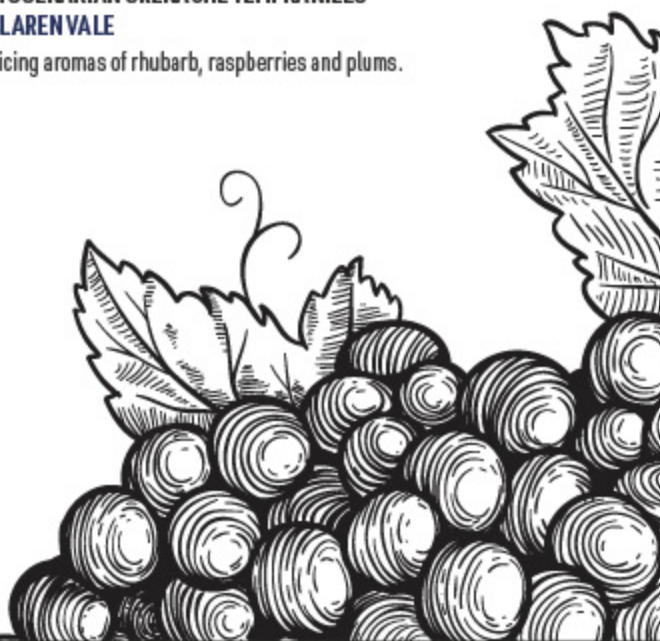

CHILE

Chile is the world's narrowest country. However, what it lacks in width, it more than makes up in length; its coastline stretches about 2,600 miles. Because of this long length, the climate in the country's wine regions vary expansively and dramatically, yet all of them benefit from lots of sunshine and mostly dry conditions. The country's dry climate makes it an excellent place to try out different organic, biodynamic, and sustainable production ideas.

Part of what makes Chilean wine so interesting is the topography from which it's grown. Its location makes the country something like an island—it's bordered by the Pacific Ocean on the west, the Andes on the East, the Atacama Desert up north, and the Patagonia toward the south. As it's naturally protected on all sides, the vineyards are protected from the elements.

LA PODEROSA

In 1952 Ernesto "Che" Guevara ventured on a magical journey through the wilderness of Patagonia on his precious Norton 500 which he nicknamed 'La Poderosa' the powerful one. The journey was immortalised by the film Motorcycle Diaries.

50 years on, Patagonia lays claim to being the southernmost wine region on earth. With the vineyards having been planted in the hot dusty tracks of this desert plain the quality of wine is now leaving its imprint on the palates of discerning wine drinkers everywhere. La Poderosa is a stunning example of the new wines from this region.

FRANCE

All common styles of wine - red, rosé, white and sparkling are produced in France. In most of these styles, the French production ranges from cheap and simple versions to some of the world's most famous and expensive examples.

In many respects, French wines have more of a regional than a national identity, as evidenced by different grape varieties, production methods and different classification systems in the various regions. Quality levels and prices vary enormously, and some wines are made for immediate consumption while other are meant for long-time cellaring. If there is one thing that most French wines have in common, it is that most styles have developed as wines meant to accompany food, be it a quick baguette, a simple bistro meal, or a full-fledged multi-course menu. Since the French tradition is to serve wine with food, wines have seldom been developed or styled as "bar wines" for drinking on their own, or to impress in tastings when young.

A dry white with a light and delicate in style, pale gold colour and fresh fruit, floral aromas leading into a refreshing palate.

Lots of fresh, herbaceous fruit with a hint of liquorice on the nose. In the mouth, there are delicious Sauvignon Blanc characteristics with citrus and gooseberry flavours.

Delicious and expressive, combining the best of Loire Valley Sauvignon Blanc with a hint of the New Zealand style. Look for lime zest and mineral, cut grass and a touch of fresh flowers.

Expressive, floral and ripe fruit flavours on the nose, with a good balance of fruit and acidity. Long finish with notes of honey and dried fruit. 100% Chenin Blanc.

An intense, rich, concentrated red wine with a peppery edge complemented by an earthy nose.

Lemon tree blossom, crunchy biscuit finish. The three classic grape varieties, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier

1 BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVEE NV - CHAMPAGNE

Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent.

1 VEUVE CLICQUOT NV - CHAMPAGNE

Clear, light straw yellow with tiny persistent bubbles. Biscuity honey finish with a lingering sweetness.

1 VEUVE CLICQUOT ROSÉ NV - CHAMPAGNE

A delightfully luscious, fruit-based charm, it has expressive aromas of strawberry and very ripe wild strawberries.

1 MOËT & CHANDON BRUT NV - CHAMPAGNE

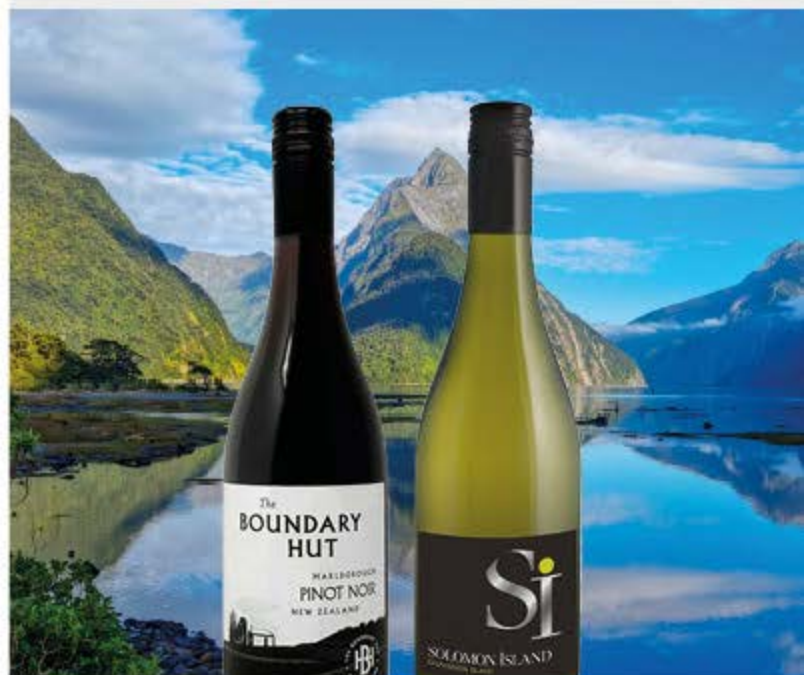

SPAIN

Located on the Iberian Peninsula, Spain has over 1.2 million hectares (2.9 million acres) planted in wine grapes, making it the most widely planted wine-producing nation, but the second largest producer of wine in the world, behind Italy and ahead of France and the United States. This is due, in part, to the very low yields and wide spacing of the old vines planted on the dry soils found in some of the Spanish wine regions.

The abundance of native grape varieties fostered an early start to viticulture with evidence of grape pits dating back to the Tertiary period. Archaeologists believe that these grapes were first cultivated sometime between 4000 and 3000 BC, long before the wine-growing culture of the Phoenicians founded the trading post of Cádiz around 1100 BC.
